The children have been incredibly mature and diligent with their work carrying out independent practice of all of the skills and knowledge that they are learning. We are concentrating on applying the skills of column addition and subtraction up to a million in real life context and worded problems where 2-steps or more are needed to solve them. In English, the children have worked have been brilliantly focused on producing a diary entry about our main character, Zoe who has ended up in an unfortunate situation on an island of Eels.

This week in Science, we have started our new topic about forces. We talked about what we already know about forces, like magnets.

It's been another busy fun filled week in Triscombe. We took our learning outside and read books and watched a puppet show we performed for each other. In Maths, Reception used stampolines to explore different ways to make 5. We enjoyed a variety of fine motor activities with threading and peg boards being the most popular, with our improved fine motor skills we will be amazing writers!









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Preschool

This week we started our week by commemorating Remembrance day. The children watched a short clip about Remembrance day and then helped to create a poppy out of red tissue paper. We also did a poppy cutting activity and drew poppies before pausing for the 2 minute silence.

For the next 3 weeks our topic is animals. this week we have been learning about the Amazon rain forest and its animals. We engaged in small world play with our Amazon tough tray and have looked through Jungle books. We have been looking at different pictures of the various animals and learning their names; some familiar ones such as tiger, monkey and snake and some new names such as tapir, jaguar and lemur. We have looked at the different patterns that animals have on their skins and matched them to the corresponding animals and counted monkeys jumping on the bed!

(We have also started practising our songs for Christmas!)
